Academic Calendar

Winter Semester

- Arrival days and orientation during the first week of October
- Lecture period: mid-October to mid-February
- Exam period: usually after the lecture period, February into March

Semester break (no classes): mid-February to mid-April

- Exam period: usually after the lecture period, mid-July into August

Important Information for degree-seeking Students



How to apply

- Nomination of each student by VSE by April 15 (for winter semester only)
- Application through “Campusportal”, from beginning of May (<https://campusportal.uni-regensburg.de>)
- **Application period:**
May 1 to JUNE 1
- As soon as your application has been processed, you will receive a letter of admission with further information

Required documents

1. **Proof of your university entrance qualification** (e.g. secondary school diploma with list of grades) in its original language (translation to German/English needed, if not in Czech)
2. **University Transcript of Records and Bachelor's diploma**, copy (original language and translation, if not in English)
3. **Copy of passport**
4. **Curriculum Vitae**
5. **Proof of Language (one of the following):**
 - TOEFL (internet-based): 79
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - DUOLINGO English Test: 105
 - Cambridge Language Certificate: 176
 - Certificate issued by the home institution confirming a level of B2 (CERF)

Getting a visa?

- If you are a citizen of the EU, you do not need a visa.

Learning German at the UR

Learning German

Pre-semester intensive language course (ILC)
Every September and March

- 12 ECTS
- All language levels from A1 – B2
- Includes orientation and events with student tutors
- Suitable for absolute beginners, „survival“ German
- But also students who want to improve/reactivate their German.
- Fee: 395 EUR

Where do students live?

In one of our Student Residences

- 99% of all exchange students live in student dorms
- Residences are not located on campus, but throughout town
- There are buses connecting all dorms with campus
- Single rooms, with shared bathroom and kitchen
- Germans and internationals, undergrads and postgrads all live together
- For application contact: international.accommodation@ur.de
- Reservation fee: 210€ (non refundable); deposit: 350€
- Application deadline: June 30

Costs of Living

- Students should expect to spend about 1000 Euro per month for living.
- This covers the costs for rent, transportation within Regensburg and the surrounding area, all fees, health insurance, residence permit and general costs for living/food.
